







HONG KONG SQUASH LEAGUE 2025/26

The Squash League 2025/26 will start on October 2, 2025. The closing date for team application is July 25, 2025. Late applications will not be considered.

Please read the following carefully before filling in the Entry Form, The form (as attached) must be fully completed. Entry forms with missing or inadequate information will be rejected.

FORMAT OF THE SQUASH LEAGUE

The Squash League comprises of Main, Ladies and Masters League, and is divided into following divisions,

Main League	Premier Main & Div 2 - Div 15
Ladies League	Premier Ladies & L2, L3, L4
Master League	Premier Master & M2, M3, M4

A maximum of 12 teams will be accepted into each division. Each team will, where possible, play the other teams in the same Division, on a home and away basis. However, in view of other considerations, there may be variations in the number of home and away matches, especially for Divisions playing 3 rounds of matches. The league fixtures are to be arranged and decided at the full discretion of the League Office.

The Squash League will consist of a series of scheduled matches announced at the start of each season. After the completion of the scheduled matches the teams finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th will enter the Final Series Championship.

Trophies will be presented to the top 3 teams in each division - Division Champions, the 1st and 2nd Runner-ups, provided that the respective division has 8 teams or more. For those with fewer than 8 teams, only the Division Champions and the 1st Runner-ups will receive trophies. The Final Series Championship winners will also receive plagues.

PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

²⁾ Depending on the number of entries and courts availability, the Squash League Sub-committee (SLSC) may make adjustments to the timetable.

ELIGIBILITY OF PLAYERS

Players must be fully paid-up members of Squash Association of Hong Kong, China and registered with their team with Squash Association of Hong Kong, China prior to playing in the Squash League. It is the responsibility of the team convenor to collect and pay the membership subscription for his/her players together with the team entry fee when the team application is submitted.

Graded Players - Premier Main & Premier Ladies

The SLSC will issue a list of Graded Players for Premier Main and Premier Ladies. Graded Players must play in No. 1 Position.

Ladies League

Lady players can choose to play in the Main League, Ladies League, or both.

Masters League

Except for Premier Master, men and ladies who have **reached the age of 40 by the scheduled date** of any given match are eligible to play in the Masters League.

For Premier Master, the minimum age is reduced to 35 or above.

Teams may comprise of both men and ladies. Players are required to provide proof of age upon the request of SLSC.

Masters players with a playing standard equivalent to Div 3 and above in the Main League must register to play in Premier Master unless with justification and the approval of SLSC.

REGISTRATION AND SEEDING OF PLAYERS

The number of players each team may register is as follows,

Full details of all players must be submitted, including English Name, Chinese Name (If applicable), Gender, Membership No. of Squash Association of Hong Kong, China (if any) and the player's Overall Ranking Points at the end of the season 2024/25. You may login to the SAHKC Membership System for checking the record of Overall Ranking Points for the end of the season 2024/25. It is the responsibility of the Team Convenor to register and seed his/her players according to their playing ability and standard and require stating the Overall Ranking Average Points of the team at the application. Team Convenor also needs to ensure that the team is eligible to play in the division that the team has applied for. The SLSC has full discretion to accept or reject any player or team registration.

The Team Assessment of season 2025/26 will be made according to the player's Overall Ranking Points at the end of the season 2024/25 to calculate the Team Average Points. The calculation will sum up the points of all the registered players and be divided by the number of the registered players to calculate the Team Average Points. For example, if the team consists of 6 players, the total score will be divided by 6. And the League Office will also take the reference of the player's results in season 2024/25 to evaluate the team order. In case the Player has not played in season 2024/25, the reference would be made to the past league seasons that the Player joined.

Team convenors are required to confirm the team order by a formal notice to the League Office on or before September 01, 2025. Otherwise, the provisional order stated in the Entry Form will be taken as confirmed.

Late submission of confirmation of team order (those received after September 01, 2025) will be counted as a change of team order. Please refer to the Squash League Regulations on the number of changes in team order allowed.

NUMBER OF DRAW UPS

Players are allowed to draw up from a lower division to play for a higher division on each occasion with the following restrictions. However, players drawn up from a lower division to any other division can only be **drawn up to the same team on each occasion**.

To Div 2 - Div 14 & M2 - M3 & L3	3 times	he/she has to move up to D2 and cannot stay in D3 anymore. Draw up is only allowed among the divisions in the same League. No draw up is permitted in the Final Series. Please refer to the League Regulation for detailed explanation on draw up.

REFEREE REFRESHER CLINIC

Players who have joined the League for the first time or newly registered players must attend a Referee Refresher Clinic or Referee Course of Squash Association of Hong Kong, China. Besides, all registered players of **Div 4-15**, **L2-L4 in the season 2025/26**, who have yet to obtain a valid attendance record **since January 1**, **2015**, are still obliged to fulfill the attendance requirement **by January 31**, **2026**. It is the responsibility of the team convenor to ensure that all of his/her players have attended such a course.

If, for any reason, a player fails to fulfill the aforementioned attendance requirement, one point per match will be deducted from the team scores for each match in which the player has played **on or after February 1, 2026**, until he/she has attended such a course. All penalty points taken away are irrevocable. In addition, all players must have met the attendance requirement to be permitted to play in the Final Series.

The League Office will arrange several Referee Refresher Clinics. Details will be further issued to team convenors in due course.

MATCH VENUES

For teams with Home Courts, full details on the proposed home court must be provided. If the courts belong to a private club, you must provide details of facilities and evidence to show that the courts are up to standard and that the club concerned will make the courts available according to the fixtures issued. The League Office may conduct site visits to inspect such courts.

For teams without home courts, the League Office will allocate and arrange the use of public courts. List of venues managed by Leisure & Cultural Services Department (LCSD) and those proposed to be used for league matches are listed in the Entry Form. Match schedule/ fixtures are arranged at the full discretion of the League Office.

LEAGUE REGULATIONS & DISCIPLINARY & APPEAL PROCEDURES

WSF Rules of the World Singles Game will be applied throughout the matches except the aforesaid league regulations outlined in this prospectus.

The League is subject to the Hong Kong Squash League Regulations and/or other regulations or requirements the SLSC may issue from time to time. The Team Convenor shall lodge an appeal to the League Office in writing with reasons justified. Appeals shall be considered and decided by the SLSC. The SLSC has absolute right to impose disciplinary action or other form of penalty on teams and players accordingly.

LIABILITIES __

Teams and their players enter and play in the Squash League at their own risk. Squash Association of Hong Kong, China and the SLSC do not accept any responsibility and shall not be liable for any injury or death or loss arising from participation.

NAME OF TEAM/ ABBREVIATED NAME

The League Office reserves the rights to change the team names and abbreviation.
